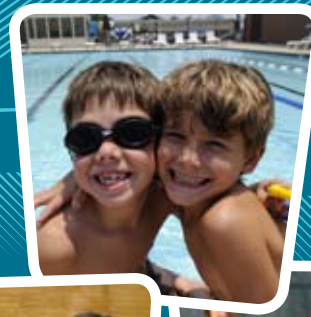

## REGISTRATION POLICY

- **JCC Membership is required to enroll your child in camp.** Please contact our Membership Directors with questions, Monika Flurer (Uptown) at monika@nojcc.org or Stephanie Krell (Metairie) at stephanie@nojcc.org.
- Priority Registration is open to current JCC members in good standing who are also returning camp families and/or current JCC Nursery School students. To register, please mail in or drop-off registration forms and a \$100 non-refundable deposit per child to the reception desk. On March 7, camp registration is open to all JCC members on a first come, first serve basis.
- Registration opens to new camp families on March 7 at 1:00 PM.
- When camp groups are filled, additional registrations will be put on a waiting list.
- All camp groups have minimum enrollment requirements.
- **ALL CAMP FORMS AND FEES ARE DUE BY MAY 14.** Medical forms MUST be signed by a licensed pediatrician.
- After May 1, a \$25 administrative processing fee will be charged for session change requests.

## INSURANCE

A \$10 insurance fee is required for ALL campers.

## CAMP T-SHIRTS

All campers will receive one complimentary t-shirt. Camp t-shirts must be worn on all field trips.

## AMERICAN RED CROSS SWIM PROGRAM

All Aquatics Staff are certified American Red Cross Water Safety Instructors (WSI). The primary goal of the JCC is to teach water safety skills and basic strokes to all campers while maintaining small group lessons tailored to the needs of each child. JCC instructors follow all American Red Cross Swim Instruction guidelines and lesson plans. Parents will receive progress reports every week from the swim instructor to ensure successful communication of your child's progress. Contact the Aquatic Directors for further details.

The New Orleans JCC maintains a policy of fee adjustment on an individual need basis. Limited funds are available for the purpose of providing financial assistance. 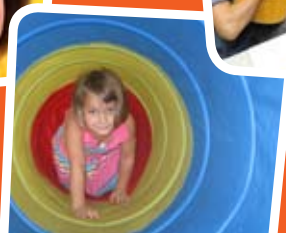

# early childhood

The Jewish Community Center's Early Childhood Summer Camps, led by our professional Early Childhood Director and Assistant Director, are designed to enhance the pre-school experience for your young child. Campers who currently attend the JCC Nursery School will benefit from continuity of care, enjoying summer in a familiar environment. For JCC newcomers, camp is a chance to experience the diversity of our membership and the loving support given by our staff. The experienced counselors provide each child with developmentally appropriate activities in the areas of art, music and sports. In addition, all children will participate in daily water play activities. Three and four year olds will also have the opportunity to participate in swim lessons led by certified American Red Cross Water Safety Instructors.

The most important aspect of the JCC Early Childhood Summer Day Camp program is the authentic play experiences your child will have each day. Young children need the space, materials, and guidance by caring and qualified adults to explore independently and in groups. JCC counselors help each child acquire knowledge, build self-esteem and learn problem solving skills. At the JCC Summer Day Camp, youngsters have fun while building the social and emotional foundations needed for future success as they grow.

# sports camp

**sports camp** will expose each camper to fun and sportsmanlike play in both team and individual scenarios. # sports specialty camps

## sports specialty camps

include a full day of programming. Afternoons will be spent at the JCC eating lunch, swimming, and participating in various athletic activities. All skill levels are welcome to participate.

**golf camp** campers will spend the first half of each day at Lakewood Country Club. A certified U.S. PGA Professional will provide top-notch instruction in the fundamentals of golf focusing on swing technique, driving, chipping, putting, pitching and more. A low camper-to-counselor ratio helps your child advance in skill level.

**tennis camp** campers will receive valuable instruction as they develop their forehand, backhand, serve, volley and net play within small group lessons at the Audubon Tennis Courts. Campers will be evaluated and grouped according to skill level.

**golf/tennis combo camp** campers will play golf at Lakewood Country Club in the first week and gain valuable instruction at the Audubon Tennis Courts in the second week.

**bowling** campers will beat the July heat as they learn more about bowling. Instructors will focus on technique, strategy, rules, scoring, safety and equipment at a local bowling alley.

# before & after care

## early morning care, second home and kids konnection

campers wake up and wind down with age-appropriate books, toys, arts and crafts, and indoor and outdoor play. An afternoon snack is provided.

The **jcc policy** is to not take responsibility for your child before 7:30 AM or after 5:30 PM on Monday – Friday. If your child stays late, there is a \$1.00 per minute late fee payable directly to the staff member who must stay with your child. This applies to Second Home, Kids Konnection, and the game room. Please arrive on time!

**game room** Campers ages 8 and older may use the adult-supervised game room free of charge during aftercare hours. However, we ask that you please indicate this on your registration form to avoid confusion. Campers in the game room are given the option to “check out” and use the swimming pool facilities. Please indicate permission on the registration form for your camper to gain access to this area.

# counselor- in-training program

This unique **counselor-in-training** (CIT) program encourages responsible young teens to work with a variety of age groups with a strong focus on developing leadership capabilities, communication skills, patience and program planning. Supplemented by specialized training sessions and teambuilding exercises, CITs leave with a heightened sense of self-worth and confidence in their own abilities in both social and educational environments.

CITs must commit to a minimum of four consecutive weeks. A personal interview and pre-camp training sessions are required. Counselors-in-Training will receive an honorarium for their hard work and dedication upon the successful completion of the program. This program is a member-only opportunity.
